

HELP! I need extra practice!

Where can I find extra practice/extra help in math class?

In your TEXTBOOK:

- Each lesson in your book has around 50 practice problems that you can use for extra help. The answers to all of the ODDS can be found in the back!
- There is a book “quiz” at the midpoint and end of each chapter.
- There is a chapter review that helps lesson by lesson at the end of each chapter.
- There is a chapter “test” at the end of each chapter that can be used as a practice test/review.

ONLINE:

- Go to www.bigideasmath.com. Make sure the book menu says Common Core 2014. Click on “I am a Student” (or your parents can click on “I am a Parent”).
- Login with your school username and password. In front of your password, type RMS. So if your normal password is 12345, then you would type RMS12345.
- **You MUST click Login.** If you hit enter on your keyboard, it won't work.
- Your entire math book, workbook, videos, etc... are available here.
- You can also find good instructional videos on YouTube.com and khanacademy.org.

In your WORKBOOK:

- Each lesson has an activity. If we don't do the activity, you could try the activity at home. Be warned, though, activities are not meant to be done on your own or without your math teacher!
- Each lesson has a “practice” page in your workbook. If it hasn't already been assigned, this is a great page to do for extra practice.

At SCHOOL:

- TCB time--If you are truly struggling to understand a lesson or concept, that is what TCB is for! I'll sign you up or you can ask me to be signed up.
- Before/After school--just set up an appointment with me ahead of time.
- In class--make sure you are asking enough questions, paying attention, listening, trying your best, and completing all assignments.
